"Why Easter Matters" - Andy Stanley

Are we too familiar with Easter? The stories of Easter are so familiar that we rarely dig into the details. But what if we did? We might find that they stop sounding like far-fetched fairy tales. In fact, the improbable details of these stories might even start to sound like real life—maybe even your life.
