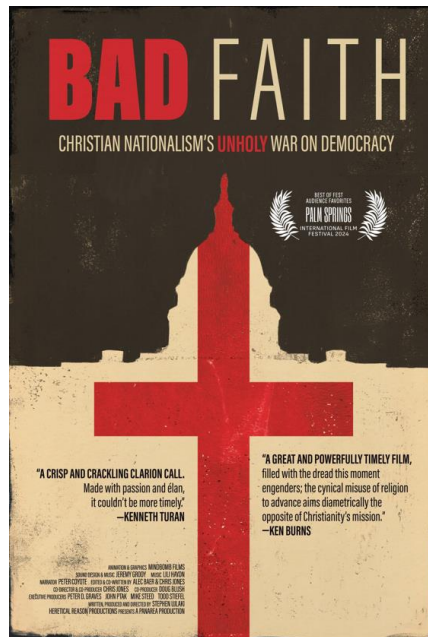

JAM (Mid-Week Children and Youth Ministry) Registration nights for the Fall Semester (September 11 – December 18) will happen on **August 28 and September 4 at 6 PM**. The youngsters and JAM staff delivered their mission project, lap blankets to folks living at Yorkview Nursing Home and Normandie Ridge. They have blankets yet to be delivered to Providence Place and Inners Creek. Now is the time to prayerfully consider what role you might take: For example, weekly possibilities include: Table Parent, Teacher, Greeter, Music Helper, Cooking Team Member. Another weekly opportunity would be setting up tables on Tuesday (not Wednesday the JAM evening). Other opportunities include providing financial support, commit to praying for the ministry, being a once a month visitor to show your support to the children (and for the fun and fellowship), being a substitute should one of the staff become ill or need to be away, or offer to be part of the clean-up crew once or twice a month (30 minute commitment or come for dinner first, then help clean-up and make it 60 minutes). We promise your heart will be filled to overflowing as you witness the making of disciples for Jesus!

However, every Sunday during the summer, ANYONE who wants to participate in singing an anthem for that particular service may do so by coming to the choir room NO later than 8:15 am.
