We were open 18 days in November. We provided supplemental groceries and personal care items to 301 people in 112 households. We assisted 148 adults, 73 seniors and 80 youth. New households were 13; 11 youth, 24 adults, and 5 seniors. **Great Job, Volunteers!!!!**
