Trinity UCC Receives Prestigious Calvin Institute Vital Worship Grant for 2025

January 7, 2025 – (Trinity UCC), a historic congregation in York, Pennsylvania, proudly announces that it has been awarded the Calvin Institute of Christian Worship's Vital Worship Grant. This significant honor will fund the groundbreaking "Worship in Motion" project, which is set to transform worship experiences throughout the 2025 calendar year.

Rev. Dr. Dominique Denman, the Director of Education and Community Outreach at Trinity UCC and the project's Director, expressed enthusiasm about the initiative. "Worship in Motion" is an innovative way to blend art and faith by using film to create meaningful connections between scripture, worship, and the contemporary issues our community faces. This grant enables us to expand our vision of worship as a space for spiritual growth and community transformation," said Rev. Dr. Denman.

The "Worship in Motion" project will integrate short films into Trinity's worship services to enhance congregational engagement, deepen scriptural reflection, and foster creative storytelling. Local filmmakers, worship leaders, and community partners will collaborate with the Trinity UCC team to produce and curate these films. Post-worship discussions and outreach events led by church staff and volunteers will invite dialogue and reflection, helping participants connect their faith to pressing social issues such as justice, reconciliation, and community healing.

"This project underscores Trinity UCC's commitment to inclusive worship and community impact," Rev. Dr. Denman added. "By leveraging the power of film, we hope to inspire both personal spiritual growth and collective action for change."

Trinity UCC's innovative approach to worship aligns with its mission to serve as a historic, giving, and inclusive congregation rooted in multicultural and artistic expression. The Calvin Institute of Christian Worship's Vital Worship Grant is a prestigious recognition that supports initiatives fostering deeper engagement in worship and vibrant congregational life.

The "Worship in Motion" project will commence in January 2025 and continue throughout the year, with a series of worship services and community events planned to showcase the films and facilitate dialogue.

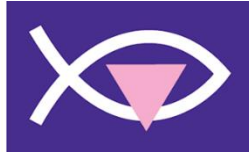
