

Mardi Gras Sunday, (Transfiguration Sunday) is the last Sunday before the season of Lent begins. On Sunday EVENING, March 2, 2025, we will gather for a DINNER CHURCH Service at 6 PM in Fellowship Hall. This will be a joyful and uplifting service. In keeping with church tradition there will be beads, hats and masks, and lots of singing.

During the service, the "keeper of the alleluia" also will be selected. The "keeper of the alleluia" is responsible for holding on to a symbolic alleluia until Easter morning, for once Lent begins, our Alleluias are silenced until Resurrection Day.

Fellowshipping with one another, while sharing a meal, celebrating Communion, reading scripture, and hearing a homily or studying a specific tradition or practice of Christianity are all important parts of a Dinner Church service. Every family unit is invited to bring a dish and/or dessert to add to the meal (but this is certainly NOT required). The church is preparing some Cajun Jambalaya, and several church members have already offered to bring a variety of soups and delicious breads. There will also be a traditional king cake with its hidden surprise! All are welcome to this festive worship service, regardless of faith tradition. Invite your friends and family to join you as we celebrate God's amazing love for humanity in a Mardi Gras Carnival Service. It will be the "last blast" before the solemn season of Lent begins.
