HEBREW READING

Jeremiah 1:4-10

RESPONSIVE EPISTLE READING

1 Corinthians 13:1-13

Liturgist: If we speak in tongues of human beings and of angels but don't have love, we are nothing more than a clanging gong or a clashing cymbal.

PULPIT Side: If we have the gift of prophecy and know all the mysteries and everything else, and if we have such complete faith that [we] can move mountains but don't have love, we are nothing.

LECTERN Side: If we give away everything that we have and hand over our bodies to feel good about what we've done but don't have love, we receive no benefit whatsoever.

All people: Love is patient; love is kind. Love isn't jealous; it doesn't brag. Love isn't arrogant; it isn't rude. Love doesn't seek its own advantage; it isn't irritable, and it doesn't keep a record of wrongs. Love doesn't rejoice in evil but rejoices with the truth. Love bears all things, trusts all things, hopes all things, endures all things. Love never fails.

PULPIT Side: As for prophecies, they will be brought to an end. As for tongues, they will stop. As for knowledge, it will be brought to an end.

LECTERN Side: Currently, we know things only in part and we prophesy in part; but when God's completeness comes, what is partial will be brought to an end.

All people: When I was a child, I used to speak like a child, reason like a child, think like a child. But now that I am mature, I've put an end to childish things.

PULPIT Side: Now we see a reflection in a mirror; someday we will see face-to-face.

LECTERN Side: Now I know only partially, but someday I will know completely in the same way that I have been completely known.

All people: Now faith, hope, and love remain—these three things—and the greatest of these is love.
