

SERVANTS SUMMER WORK CAMPS

Servants' summer work camps are week-long mission opportunities in York County that focus on residential home repair for people in need. Projects range from yard work and painting to bathroom modifications and wheelchair ramps.

More importantly, participants spend the week serving Christ through serving others; building relationships with our homeowners and each other, transforming lives through meeting physical, spiritual, and emotional needs, and providing hope to their community!

Workday Schedule

7:00 - Breakfast and devotion @ host site

8:00 - Depart for work sites

12:00 - lunch break

4:00 - clean up & return to most site

5:00 - Dinner

- FLEXIBLE SCHEDULE

Work camps are flexible — you can serve for the entire week or select the days/times that best fit your schedule!

There is a mandatory orientation meeting at 6:30pm on Sunday evening before the camp starts. This meeting is held at the host site.

Meals are provided each day of work camp — breakfast and dinner are served at the host site, and bagged lunches are packed in the morning and taken along to the work site.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS-

How much does it cost?

Servants does not charge people to participate in our work camps. However, we are a non-profit and rely on donations to offset our costs. The average cost for constructions materials is \$750 per project. We also incur costs for food and drinks during the work camp week. A suggested donation of \$75 per participant would be greatly appreciated.

Should I bring my own tools?

Servants will provide all required tools and materials, as well as oversight for each project. It may be helpful to bring your own hand tools (hammer, tape measure, square, etc.). If you bring any personal tools, please mark them with your name.

What should I wear?

We require closed-toed shoes or boots, knee-length shorts or jeans, and modest tops. You will be performing construction type work and should dress appropriately for safety.

Where do we sleep?

Servants does not provide overnight accommodations during work camps. Most volunteers travel to their own homes each night. If you or your group are traveling from out-of-town, you are responsible for securing overnight accommodations.

How do I get to the work site?

You are responsible for providing transportation to and from the work site each day. It may be possible to carpool with other members of your team.

Is there an age restriction for volunteers?

We do not have any age restrictions; however, we do have some guidelines for children and youth who are serving. For youth groups, we request a ratio of 1 leader for every 5 youth. We also welcome youth and children under the age of 14, but ask that they serve directly alongside a parent, guardian, or youth leader.
