LITANY OF CONFESSION OF SIN

Pastor: Holy One, when we come to you hungry, could it be that we've not been feasting adequately on your Word...

All: *Word of God, feed me.*

Pastor: Holy One, there are times when we lose our way; could it be that we've been running around in circles, following after the words of those who do not truly care for our souls?

All: *Word of God, lead me.*

Pastor: Holy One, when we are stuck in repetitive habits; could it be that we have grown comfortable with the status quo and have settled for mediocrity...or even less?

All: *Word of God, shake me.*

Pastor: Holy One, when our hearts have turned cold toward this world and the people in whom you love, could it be that we have forgotten your compassion and mercy towards us?

All: *Word of God, break me.*

Pastor: "The Word of God is living and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit. It can separate joints from bones. It judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart." (Hebrews 4:12)

All: *Holy One, through your Living Word, feed me with your wisdom; lead me with your love; shake me with your reality; break me with your perspective and rebuild me with the power of your Holy Spirit. Amen.*

ASSURANCE OF FORGIVENESS²

Pastor: Hear the Good News: When we wonder if the weary and weakened, dry and brittle, disjointed and scattered bones of our spirits and lives can ever live again, the Holy Word of God comes to us, saying: I will put my Spirit in you, and you will live.

All: *When our soul finds rest and is settled, we will know that the LORD has spoken and it is the Lord who has done it! AMEN!*

OLD TESTAMENT READING – Ezekiel 37:1-14 (NIV)

The hand of the LORD was on me, and he brought me out by the Spirit of the LORD and set me in the middle of a valley; it was full of bones. ²He led me back and forth among them, and I saw a great many bones on the floor of the valley, bones that were very dry. ³He asked me, "Son of man, can these bones live?"

I said, "Sovereign LORD, you alone know."

⁴Then he said to me, "Prophesy to these bones and say to them, 'Dry bones, hear the word of the LORD! ⁵This is what the Sovereign LORD says to these bones: I will make breath enter you, and you will come to life. ⁶I will attach tendons to you and make flesh come upon you and cover you with skin; I will put breath in you, and you will come to life. Then you will know that I am the LORD.'"

⁷So I prophesied as I was commanded. And as I was prophesying, there was a noise, a rattling sound, and the bones came together, bone to bone. ⁸I looked, and tendons and flesh appeared on them and skin covered them, but there was no breath in them.

⁹Then he said to me, "Prophesy to the breath; prophesy, son of man, and say to it, 'This is what the Sovereign LORD says: Come, breath, from the four winds and breathe into these slain, that they may live.'" ¹⁰So I prophesied as he commanded me, and breath entered them; they came to life and stood up on their feet—a vast army.

¹¹Then he said to me: "Son of man, these bones are the people of Israel. They say, 'Our bones are dried up and our hope is gone; we are cut off.' ¹²Therefore prophesy and say to them: 'This is what the Sovereign LORD says: My people, I am going to open your graves and bring you up from them; I will

bring you back to the land of Israel. ¹³ Then you, my people, will know that I am the LORD, when I open your graves and bring you up from them. ¹⁴ I will put my Spirit in you, and you will live, and I will settle you in your own land. Then you will know that I the LORD have spoken, and I have done it, declares the LORD.”

This is the Word of the Lord. Let all the people say, “Thanks be to God.”

NEW TESTAMENT READING – Matthew 4:4-11(NIV)

⁴ Jesus answered, “It is written: ‘Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.’”

⁵ Then the devil took him to the holy city and had him stand on the highest point of the temple. ⁶ “If you are the Son of God,” he said, “throw yourself down. For it is written:

“‘He will command his angels concerning you,
and they will lift you up in their hands,
so that you will not strike your foot against a stone.’”

⁷ Jesus answered him, “It is also written: ‘Do not put the Lord your God to the test.’”

⁸ Again, the devil took him to a very high mountain and showed him all the kingdoms of the world and their splendor. ⁹ “All this I will give you,” he said, “if you will bow down and worship me.”
