Andy Stanley - What Makes You Happy: It's Not What You'd Expect

Everybody wants to be happy. Everybody is on a happiness quest. For many, happiness is measured in moments. Experiences. It's elusive. Unsustainable. What about you? What makes you happy? Not Sure? In this six-session DVD Bible study, pastor Andy Stanley examines the ways in which we tend to define *happiness* and explains how that definition influences the way we pursue it. He reveals that happiness is about *who*, not *what*, and that happy people are at peace with God, with others, and with themselves. He also shows how sin undermines peace because it separates us from God, others, and ourselves by substituting pleasure for fulfillment, things for people, images for intimacy, and self-expression for self-control.

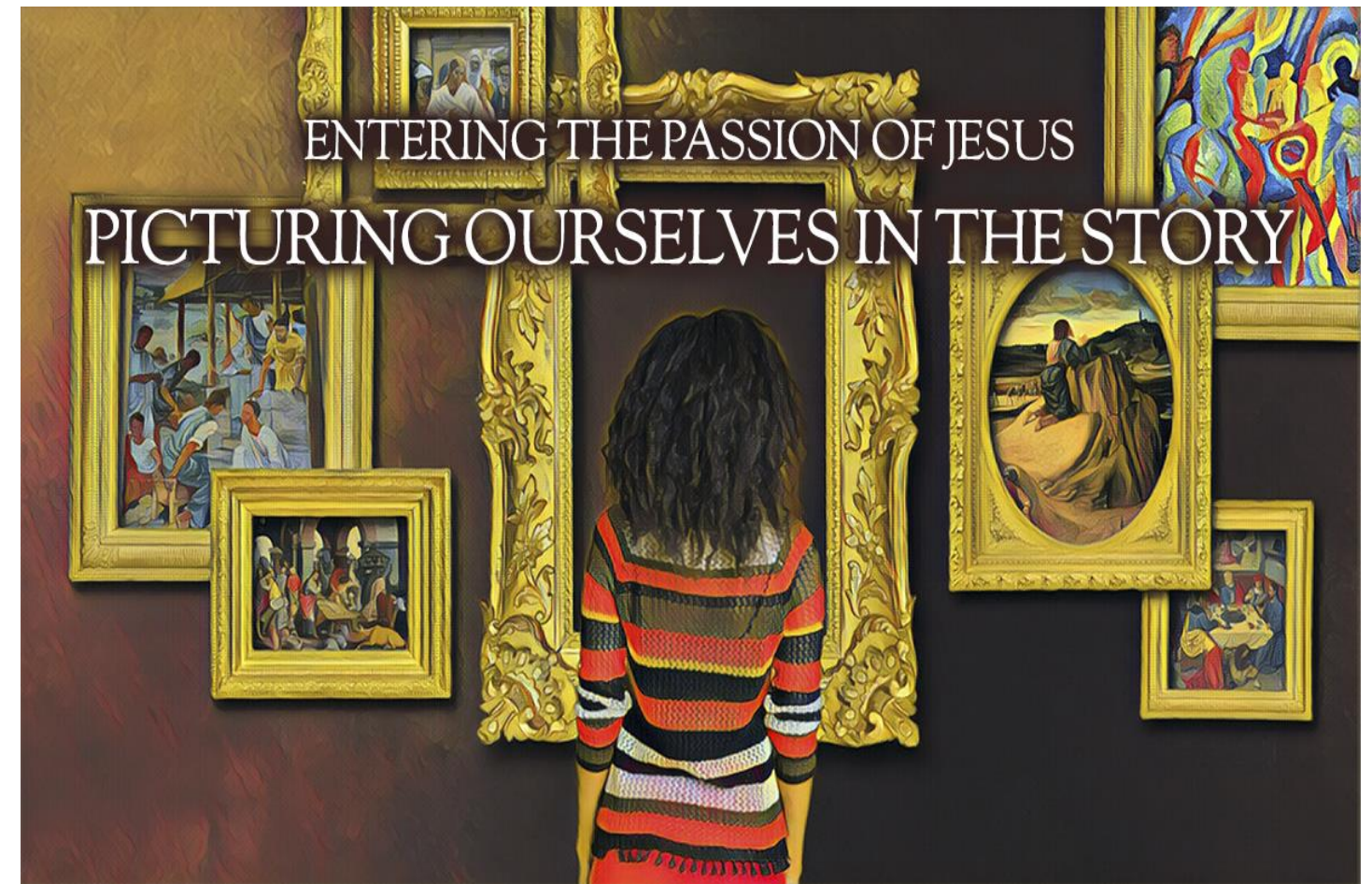
