Penn Central Conference Special Fall (Keystone Vote) Meeting

Saturday, November 9, 2024, 9:30AM - 12:30PM

The special fall meeting of the Penn Central Conference of the United Church of Christ will be held on **Saturday, November 9, 2024, at 9:30 am EST**. The meeting will be held in the sanctuary of St. Thomas United Church of Christ, 6490 Linglestown Rd., Harrisburg, PA 17112, and remote participation will be available via ZOOM. Church delegates (usually two per church) and authorized UCC clergy in the four Pennsylvania Conferences can vote.

Our York Association will also be hosting a remote gathering at St. Paul’s UCC, 2173 Stoverstown Rd, Spring Grove to allow collective participation in the meeting via ZOOM.

There are three items of business on the agenda for this meeting.

1. Presentation and approval of the proposed 2025 Penn Central Conference budget
2. Presentation and consideration for recognition of the STAR (Small Town and Rural Churches) Coalition as a self-created group within the United Church of Christ
3. Consideration and voting on a motion to create the Keystone Conference out of the four present Conferences of Penn Central, Penn Northeast, Penn West, and Pennsylvania Southeast.

The motion to create the Keystone Conference may not be amended. All four (4) Conferences are required to vote on the same motion. All four Conferences must have a 2/3 (66.67%) affirmative vote in order for the motion to pass. If the motion is approved, it would come before the 35th General Synod of the United Church of Christ in July 2025. The vote on the motion to create the Keystone Conference is scheduled to occur at 11:30 am by each of the Conferences. The tallying of votes and the reporting of the vote within Penn Central Conference will be shared.

York Association Annual Meeting

Our York Association Annual Meeting will be held on *Sunday, November 10, at 2:00 pm*. The meeting will be held in the sanctuary of *Faith UCC, 509 Pacific Ave, in York*. Church representatives (usually two per church) and authorized UCC clergy in the York Association can vote. ZOOM participation will also be available. Details TBD.

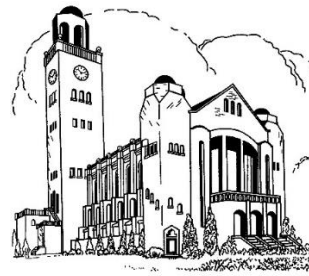
Our program will be “Association Covenants in the UCC” led by the Rev. Dr. Carrie Call.

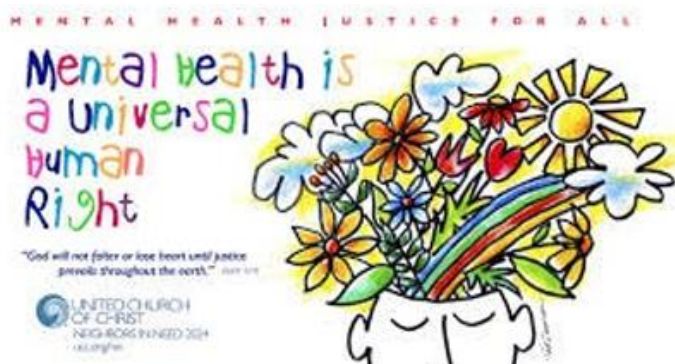
Neighbors In Need (NIN) Offering Information
