7:00 p.m. and 11:15 p.m.**

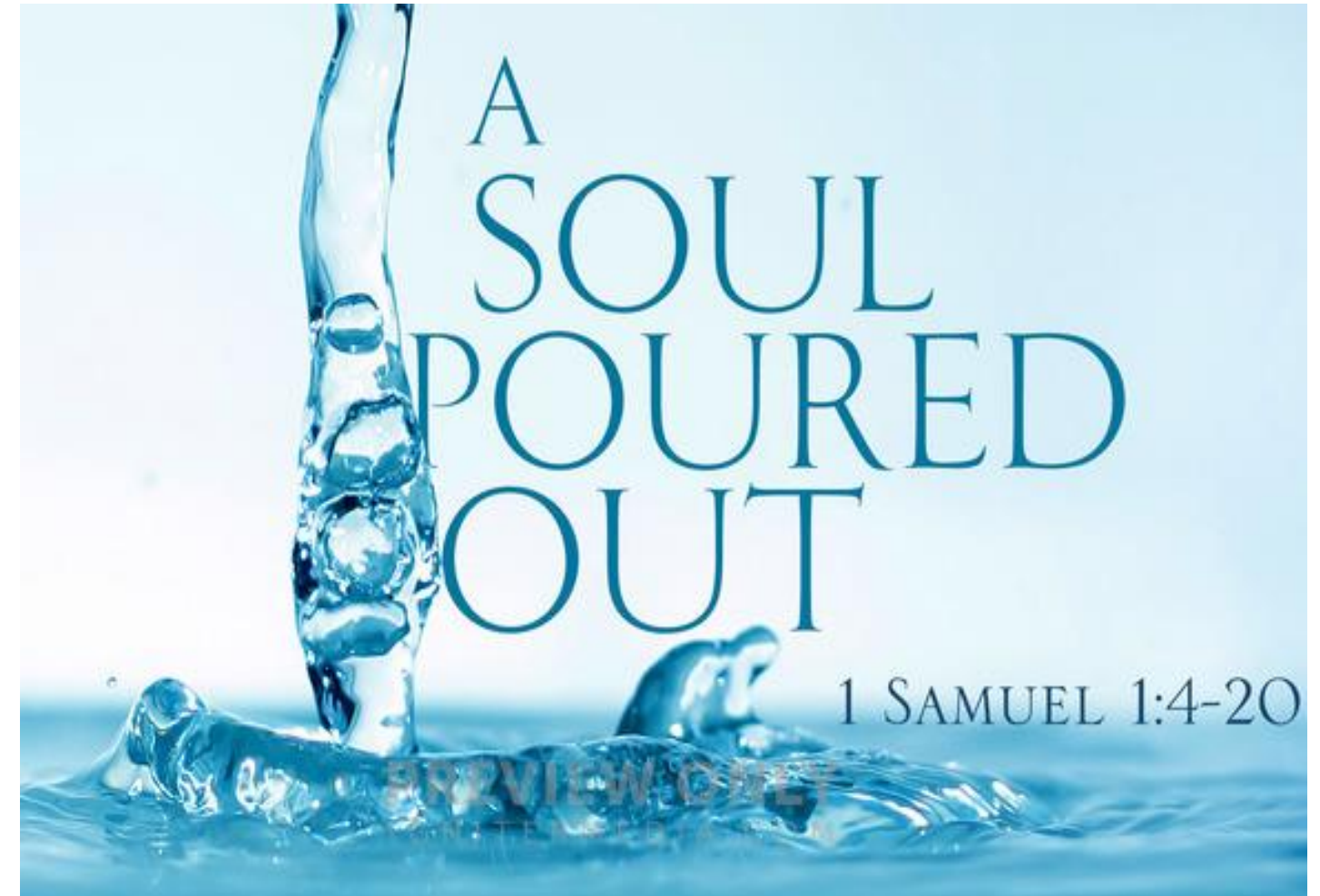
