### **OFFERING INVITATION**

Liturgist: In Second Corinthians, chapter 9, verses 6 through 8, we hear these words:  
“Remember this — a farmer who plants only a few seeds will get a small crop. But the one who plants generously will get a generous crop. You must each decide in your heart how much to give. And don’t give reluctantly or in response to pressure. ‘For God loves a person who gives cheerfully.’ And God will generously provide all you need. Then you will always have everything you need and still have plenty left over to share with others.”
